Capital Campaign Requirement: \$4.9M

The Council jointly with the Building Committee based on the recommendations of the Long Range Planning Committee move that:

1. Launch a capital fund campaign to raise funds for the proposed Community Center and spend up to \$30,000 for campaign expenses.
2. Engage Pflugger Associates to complete the design and drawings at a cost of roughly \$300,000 or 6% of the total project cost.
